RE: Debate scheduled April 11, 2018

Dear Mr. Muth,

I am in receipt of your letter, dated March 26, 2018. I double-checked our recent correspondence, and, due to your non-acknowledgement of our response, which was sent March 20, 2018, I had resent our response, on March 22, 2018, to you and your candidate. You replied you would get to it "sometime this weekend". I took the time to remind you, very clearly, that the deadline stated in the letter was March 23, 2018, at 6 pm.

After reading through your customary vitriol, I understand this from your letter:

1. You are evidently worried that your candidate will not have the use of the internet during a debate, to either look up the answers or to have the answers fed to him, undoubtedly by you.
2. You are obviously concerned that your candidate will need to recover from a poor performance and you wish to have more debates scheduled to recover from that.

As you have been informed, Dr. Bradley has accepted the very reasonable and polite debate invitation, in a timely manner. He requested certain changes, which were negotiated. The only people who are having difficulty with this offer are you and your candidate.

Not following up in a timely fashion, and a refusal to follow any sort of directions, is a recurring theme with your candidate, behavior which recently led to the closure and/or suspension of two of his brothels. It seems that you have the same problematic behavior. In addition, you have yet to send actual negotiations; instead demanding that the entire format and venue be changed, apparently to support your own over-blown sense of self-importance and to allow you to blame us when your candidate either does not do well or does not attend at all.

Since the debate is set and agreed upon by two of the participants, if your candidate wishes to now participate, please let me know and I will relay your request to both other candidates for consideration. Obviously, since you never sent any genuine negotiations, and you have disregarded the deadline of March 23, 2018, at 6 pm, negotiations, from you or your candidate, will not be considered.
